

Almont Community Schools Board Goals 2022-23 School Year

GOAL #1:

Almont Community Schools shall continue to be fiscally responsible

- 1. Establish and maintain a balanced budget.
- 2. Limit deficit spending.
- 3. Continue to use site based and zero-based budgeting.
- 4. Capitalize on unanticipated savings to add to fund balance as possible.
- 5. Support the priority of the district goals by focusing expenditures on academic programs, student achievement and staff development.

GOAL#2

Almont Community Schools shall continue to analyze, evaluate, and revise the curriculum to meet the needs of our students.

Strategies:

- 1. Use Cognia performance standards to achieve measurable, meaningful improvement throughout the district.
- 2. Require site level monthly updates on curriculum including guest speakers and superintendent reports.
- 3. Offer opportunities to close the achievement gap that occurred as a result of COVID guidelines.
- 4. Ensure a process for review, revision, and supports in implementing curriculum with a focus on student learning. (Curriculum Cycle/ESSERS)

GOAL#3

Almont Community Schools shall communicate effectively with all Almont community stakeholders Strategies:

- 1. Almont Community Schools will maintain communication with the community, including social media.
- 2. The Superintendent and Administrators shall monitor the communication and transfer of information from school to school to assist in student transitions.
- 3. The Superintendent will continue to market Almont Community Schools.
- 4. The Superintendent will engage in survey utilization with students, parents and staff throughout the academic year with focus on the current curriculum
