*Be prepared to attend, as our guest, the **Saturday**, April **15**, **2023** Lincoln Day Dinner**, at the Bells Event Center, Almont, for recognition and the announcement of the scholarship winner.

*The winning applicant is asked to attend the **Thursday, April 20, 2023**, Lapeer County Republican Executive meeting at the Lapeer VFW Hall (Daley Road) for the presentation of their \$1000 check.

Writing the paper:

The typed paper will be 750-1000 words in length. [Your paper may be longer but may not be shorter]

1-inch margins

12-point font [Times New Roman, Arial, Cambria, or Calibri font]

The essay should be clearly written, well organized and have well developed ideas.

The essay should include five (5) or more appropriate sources.

All works must be cited.

The essay will be written in the proper MLA FORMAT.
