
## Vincent Festerman Memorial Scholarship

## Scholarship criteria:

- 1. The student must be planning to attend an accredited college or university.
- 2. A true desire to succeed in a chosen field indicated by previous personal or private successes and initiatives. An example may be a steady work history, community involvement, athletic PARTICIPATION, or similar situations.
- 3. A letter of recommendation from at least one educator at Almont High School that illustrates the individual's responsibility, potential for success in the future, work ethic and respect level accorded by peers and staff.
- 4. A written essay of 500 words describing:
  - a. The reason the individual should be considered for Vincent Festerman Memorial Scholarship and
  - b. The individual's goals and plans for the future.
- 5. The student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better.
- 6. The student must fill out the Vincent Festerman Memorial Scholarship application.
