School Cancellation Procedure

The safety of our students at Almont Community Schools is of primary concern. The closing of school due to emergency conditions or weather conditions is very complex.

School may be cancelled when weather and/or road conditions are unsafe for our buses, student drivers, and/or students who walk to school. The Superintendent of Schools compiles data from numerous sources including the district's Transportation Supervisor regarding the ability of the bus fleet to safely maneuver the roads, various weather bureaus on current as well as changing weather conditions, other school districts, and police agencies.

When schools are closed, the information is given to several media sources. Parents are encouraged to tune into the following **television stations**: Channel 2 WJBK, Channel 4 WDIV, Channel 5 WNEM, Channel 7 WXYZ, and Channel 12 WJRT, or **radio stations**: WJR 760 AM, WWJ 950 AM, WPHM 1380 AM, WMPC, and WRXF 103.1 FM. In addition, Channels 4 and 7 offer assistance through the World Wide Web at *ClickOnDetroit.com* (click the school closings link at the top) and *abc12.com* (click the wireless link in the blue toolbox) to find listings of school closings/delays.

Kids' Club is available on days when school is dismissed early, and it is closed when school is cancelled. Parents may wish to contact local day care programs for the care of their children on inclement weather days. **Pre-planning by parents is imperative!**
