#### **Finished Business:**

 $2^{nd}$  Annual Fun Run - Fun Run was moved to the rain date of Friday, May  $24^{th}$ . The weather was cold, but the kids did really well. As of today the Fun Run made a profit of \$6,018! The money used to purchase t-shirts for those that raised \$30 or more will come out of that \$6018 dollars. The Fun Run shirts were ordered and will be sent home before the last day of school.

<u>Playground Update</u> - Bob Jones and Rick Throop will be meeting with Mrs. McWilliams on June 5<sup>th</sup> to discuss excavation. Judi and Robyn will continue to chair this event and hope to see some of the improvements worked on over the summer.

<u>Box Top Contest</u> – The last Box Top contest of the year just finished and was won by Mrs. Clark's class. Her class brought in over 2,200 box tops! In total the school brought in over 13,000 during this contest. Look for another contest to be held in the fall.

<u>BW3 Fundraiser held on May 5<sup>th</sup></u> – We made a profit of \$248 at this event. Kim Frederick will be sending a thank you card to the business for allowing us to have this fundraiser at their location. They have been very generous to our school and we hope to have another fundraiser or two like this one next year.

<u>Field Day –</u> The event went very well. Thank you to Mrs. Bassols and all the volunteers who made the event a success. The weather was beautiful and the kids had a wonderful time. Also the event was only about \$50 over budget, which isn't too bad. Now the volunteers are working on cleaning up and storing all the equipment for the year.

### **Current Business:**

<u>Detroit Red Wings Assembly</u> – Jennifer Fournier informed the group about a great opportunity we have next year to host a Detroit Red Wings Assembly and possible fundraiser at our school! We have a tentative date set for Wed. Jan. 22<sup>nd</sup> at 10 a.m. Cindy Jones reminded us to check and see if that is a late start date.

<u>Apples for Students Update</u> – We are in need of someone to go to Vinckiers on a weekly basis to pick empty out the collection box.
