Know an expecting mom in her 3rd trimester?

Count the Kicks is a free app that helps expecting moms pay attention to baby's movements in their 3rd trimester. The app records how long it takes for your baby to get to 10 movements, tracks changes over time, and reminds you to count every day. If you notice a change, contact your medical provider. Using this app has saved babies lives.
